## **STANLY COUNTY TAX CERTIFICATION FOR TRANSFER OF PROPERTY**

**Whereas**, N.C.G.S. 161-31 authorizes the Board of Commissioners by resolution to require the Register of Deeds to not accept any deed transferring real property for registration unless the County Tax Collector has certified that no delinquent ad valorem taxes, or other taxes with which the collector is charged are a lien on the property described in the deed; and

**Whereas,** N.C.G.S. 161-31(a1) excepts from the Tax Collector certification requirement deeds that contain the following statement, "This instrument prepared by : \_\_\_\_\_\_, a licensed North Carolina attorney. Delinquent taxes, if any, to be paid by the closing attorney to the county tax collector upon disbursement of closing proceeds."
